TIPS FOR THE BATHROOM

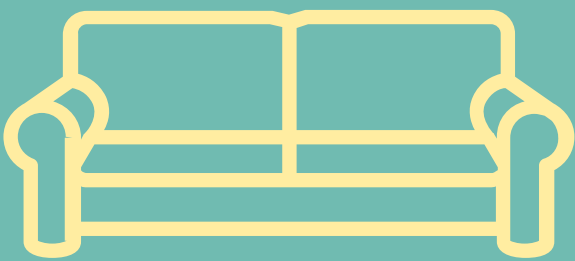

- Cabinet locks
- Toilet seat locks
- Keep medications out of reach
- Ensure the bath water doesn't get too hot to prevent burns
- Put the garbage can out of reach

GENERAL SAFETY TIPS:

- Ensure the smoke and carbon monoxide detectors work
- Have a first aid kit
- Have outlet covers
- Use furniture mounts to prevent large pieces from falling



TIPS FOR THE LIVING ROOM

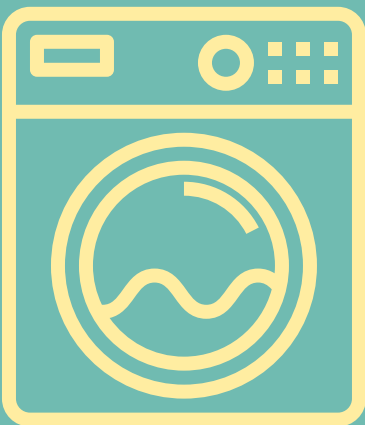

- Cover the sharp coffee table corners
- Watch out for electrical or window cords
- Install window guards
- Always watch your baby near the fireplace

TIPS FOR THE KITCHEN

- Covers for the stove knobs
- Keep knives and sharp appliances out of reach
- Cabinet locks
- Unplug appliances and put up cords to prevent tripping
- Clear edges so items can't fall on the baby
- Keep matches hidden



TIPS FOR THE LAUNDRY ROOM

- Childproof garbage can
- Keep detergent out of the way
- Be aware that the colorful laundry pods can look like candy

TIPS FOR THE NURSERY

- Keep the mattress on the lowest option in the crib
- Mount the dresser to the wall
- An open toy box is better than one with a lid to prevent hurting the baby's fingers
- Cordless window covering

TIPS FOR THE HOME OFFICE

- Put an external door lock to keep baby from getting into cords, paper clips, staples, etc.
